


Application Instructions

Titania is a permanent, invisible protective coating designed for use on any surface. Once applied correctly, the appearance will be preserved and protected against UV, oxidation, staining, fading and abrasion.

Titania is extremely tough to remove once it has dried, precaution must be used during the application:

If the product is allowed to build up on the surface and dry, an opaque film will be permanently visible. Always keep a microfiber cloth handy during the application to wipe up any drops or overspray.

Titania is always the final step in the detail process. Make sure the boat's appearance is how you want it to look, Titania will preserve that look. The paint correction process should be performed first, Wipe down any water spots, grease marks, dirt, grime etc. Titania will lock them in and you wont be able to rem'ove them afterwords



Titania requires 48 hours to fully dry, cure, and bond to the surface. If there are any drops or overspray, they can be wiped off within the first hour. If you notice any mistakes or overspray in the first day, you can use a cleaner and microfiber towel to wipe it off. After 48 hours, Titania is permanently bonded to the surface, and the boat's appearance will be preserved. Instructions for use

Make sure the surface is clean and clear of all dirt, growth, algae, etc.

Shake well before use.

Pour contents of the bottle into a fine mist spray bottle.

Spray product 12 inches from the surface.

Use a roller or paint edger to spread evenly.

Wait 45 minutes then wipe off any residue.

Wait 24 hours before putting the boat in the water.
